**Basic Math Operations**  
Multiplication and Division

## MULTIPLICATION

Multiplication is the math operation that performs repeated addition. It is a shortcut to find the total number of items in equal groups. Bianca's family has 3 cars, and each car has 4 seats. How many seats are there in all? We have three groups, with four items in each group. We are really adding 4 three separate times. The total amount of items in the picture will be the answer to our problem. We can find the answer by counting the total number of items, or by adding  $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$ . We could use multiplication to come to this same answer: 3 groups of 4 items = 12 items, or  $3 \times 4 = 12$ . The two numbers that we multiply together are *factors*, and the answer to a multiplication problem is the *product*.
